




Connection Diagram






LED forward current vs. Ambient temperature




Continuous load current vs. Ambient temperature




LED forward current vs. LED forward voltage




Continuous load current vs. On-state voltage




On-state resistance vs. Ambient temperature




Trigger LED forward current vs. Ambient temperature




Turn ON, Turn OFF time vs. LED forward current


